



First Call for Posters for the 60th California Forest Pest Council Annual Meeting.

Where: Wildland Fire Training and Conference Centre, McClelland, CA.

When: November 15 & 16, 2011

- ❖ While the 60th annual meeting will be held in the same place as last year and almost on the same dates, the focus of the 2011 meeting will be Nov 15th and 16th, 2011.
- ❖ To round out the meeting the California Forest Pest Council Annual Meeting will hold a poster viewing session during the afternoon social.

- ❖ Posters should broadly relate to some aspect of forest health, such as forest insects and disease, animal damage, competing vegetation, abiotic effects such as pollution and climate, etc.
- ❖ Posters should be constructed so they can be attached directly to a wall (with masking tape for push pins are not allowed) and should be available for both days of the meeting. Poster size can vary but should not exceed 4' x 6'.
- ❖ Posters can be displayed any time after 10:00 am on the 15th with the official viewing session beginning at 3:00pm that day. Posters should be removed after the second day of the meeting at 4:30 pm on November 16th.

- ❖ In recent years the poster session at this meeting has grown and it has become a significant venue for both new and established researchers to get exposure for their work. Should you be unable to attend but still willing to submit a poster contact Martin MacKenzie (mmackenzie@fs.fed.us), who will ensure that your research is publicized and your poster carefully returned.
- ❖ While we anticipate having another highly productive meeting with an interesting slate of speakers, as in past years the poster session is part of what makes the meeting so valuable to so many, thus I encourage you to consider your research release for our meeting.
