

First Call for Posters for the 63nd California Forest Pest Council Annual Meeting.

- The California Forest Pest Council Annual Meeting will hold a poster viewing session during the afternoon social.
- Posters should broadly relate to some aspect of forest health, such as forest insects and disease, animal damage, competing vegetation, abiotic effects such as pollution and climate, etc.
- ❖ Posters should be constructed so they can be attached directly to a wall (with masking tape for push pins are not allowed) and should be available for both days of the meeting. Poster size can vary but should not exceed 4' x 6'.
- ❖ Posters can be displayed any time after 1:00 pm on the 20th with the official viewing session beginning at 5:00pm that day. Posters should be removed after the second day of the meeting at 4:30 pm on November 13th
